

# **SUPPLY LIST**

## **DUCK POND OVERNIGHT CAMPING – TROOP 172**

Each scout and adult will carry the troop supplies. Leave room in/on your backpack.

- **NO ELECTRONICS!**
  - Leave all music and gaming devices at home
- **Backpack**
  - For personal and troop supplies including tents, tarps, ground cloths, cooking supplies, lanterns and food
- **Sleeping Bag**
  - Tightly rolled in a plastic bag or covered with plastic
- **Sleeping Bag Pad**
  - For cushioning and moisture protection
- **Camping Pillow**
  - Or use a clothes-stuffed pillowcase
- **Day Pack**
  - Day hike. Bottled water, rain gear, sweater, etc.
- **Waterproof Jacket & Warm Sweatshirts**
  - Think layers!
- **Change of Clothes**
  - Store in plastic bag.
- **Warm Socks**
  - Two or three pairs (wick away or wool)
- **Boots and Sneakers**
  - Worn in and comfortable
- **Flash Light, Mini Lantern and Extra Batteries**
- **Scout Handbook, Pen and Paper**
- **Toiletries**
  - Tooth brush, toothpaste, handy wipes, etc.
- **Mess Kit**
  - Or plastic plate, cup, bowl, fork, spoon & knife

- **Two Bottles of Water or Canteens**
  - All drinking & washing water is carried in
- **Non-Aerosol Bug Repellant, Sunscreen and Hat**
- **Deck of Cards, Mad Libs, etc.**
- **Army Knife**
  - Blade must be shorter than the width of your hand
- ***Optional***
  - Extra bags, zip lock, etc
  - Small first aid kit
  - Small sewing kit
  - Camera
